Friday evening everyone went to the Top of the River Restaurant for a wonderful fish dinner. Later that evening a rousing game of Chase the Ace was played in the club house.

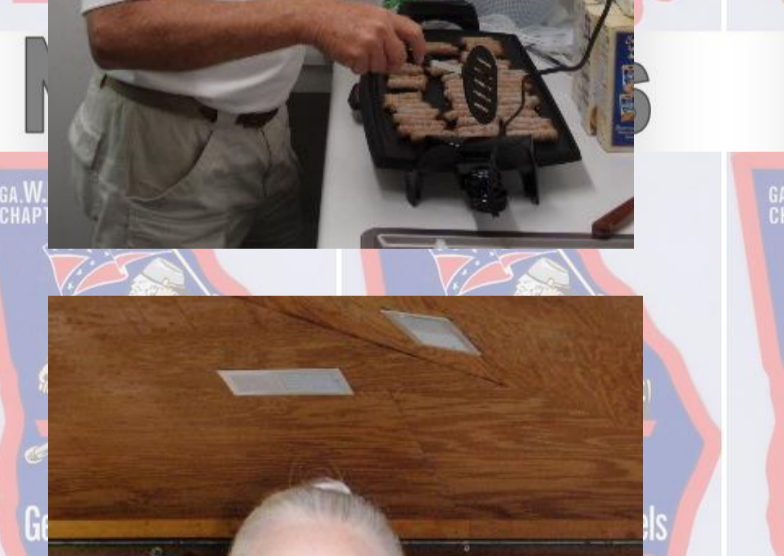
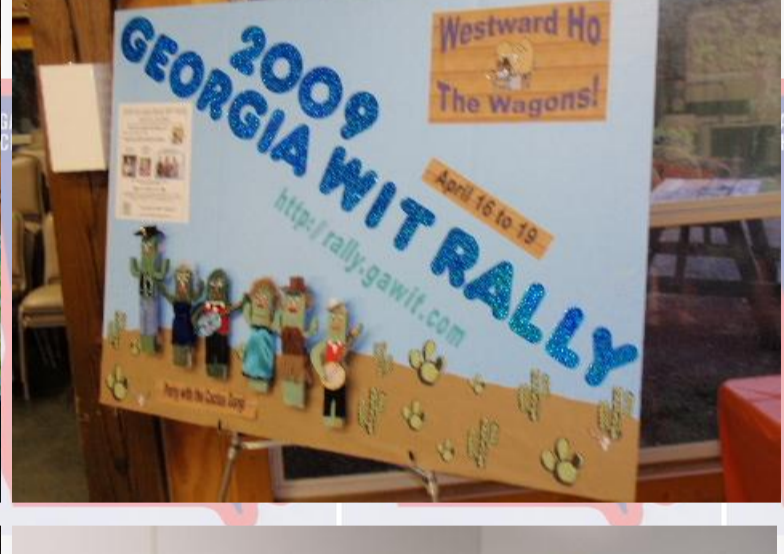
