### Winnebago Industries 50 Years on the Road:

After producing travel trailers, pop-up campers, caps for pick-up beds and also slide-in truck campers, 1966 marked the production of Winnebago Industries' first self-contained motor home. This first unit was 19-feet long and built on a Ford chassis.

By the end of the year, the Company created the famous D22 motor home, built on a Dodge chassis for the 1967 model year. It had a box shape, an eye-brow style front design and of course, the "flying W" on the side!
