In 1977, Winnebago Industries achieved an industry first by producing its 100,000th unit, the first RV manufacturer to reach that production level. By the end of 2007, the Company reached the milestone of producing its 400,000th motor home!

Other highlights of the 1970s included the Company being listed on the New York Stock exchange with the symbol WGO, and the introduction of the Itasca line of motor homes built on the Chevrolet chassis.
