### **GUIDELINES FOR HOSTING** **A STATE CLUB OUTING**

*Updated 12-2021*

The purpose of the Georgia Winnie Rebels (Club) is to provide an opportunity for persons having the common bond of owning Winnebago products to get together, have fun and fellowship with each other. The primary method of accomplishing this goal is through monthly campouts or "outings". One of the best ways to enjoy the Club fully is to serve as a volunteer "Hosts" for a weekend outing or a Saturday lunch outing. This can be done as one person, a couple or multiple couples.

#### **GUIDE TO SERVING AS A HOST:**

1. The most important job as a host is to select a campground/restaurant for everyone to meet. You will make arrangements with the campground/restaurant, letting them know you represent the Georgia Winnie Rebels (Club). Typically, you will advise the campground of the number of expected coaches: confirm the nightly rate and advise the Club how to register usually by notifying the Club secretary and she/he will send out the information via email to Club members. The Club recommends that each coach be responsible for making their reservation directly with the designated campground and then notify the host that they will be attending.
2. The hosts will determine how we will handle the meals. Generally, this is Friday night, Saturday (breakfast, lunch, dinner) and Sunday morning. This can be as simple as selecting a restaurant or a covered dish, hot dog cookout or "on your own". It is totally up to the hosts as to what they want to do. If we choose to cook, the Club will reimburse the hosts for expenses. See "Hosting Reimbursement" below.
3. The host can plan the weekend activities for the Club or can have the schedule be "on your own". It is a good idea to have a written "Agenda" for the weekend which can be sent via email to all members by the Club secretary and then given out at the outing.
4. The hosts will advise the President and Secretary of plans for upcoming outings. It is critical the campground be identified so it can be listed in the national WIT new magazine.

**HOSTING REIMBURSEMENT** - Reimbursement will be issued to the host(s) up to \$10.00 per person attending the Club outings held each month except December. The December Christmas outing reimbursement will be issued to the host(s) up to \$15.00 per person. The reimbursement will include all necessary food and supplies for a particular outing (but does not include coffee and coffee supplies which will be reimbursed separately).

Coffee and supplies include: coffee, creamer, sugar/sweetener and coffee cups. These will be reimbursed separately and will not be included in the host(s) \$10 or \$15 reimbursement.

Register receipts are required for payment. Please submit register receipts to the Club treasurer for reimbursement.

Serving as host can be very rewarding and fun. If you have any questions concerning the role, please ask any officer or any member who has hosted.
