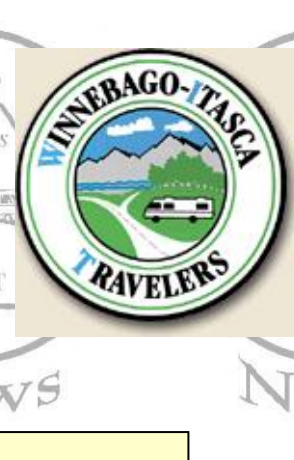




Metro Atlanta Winnies

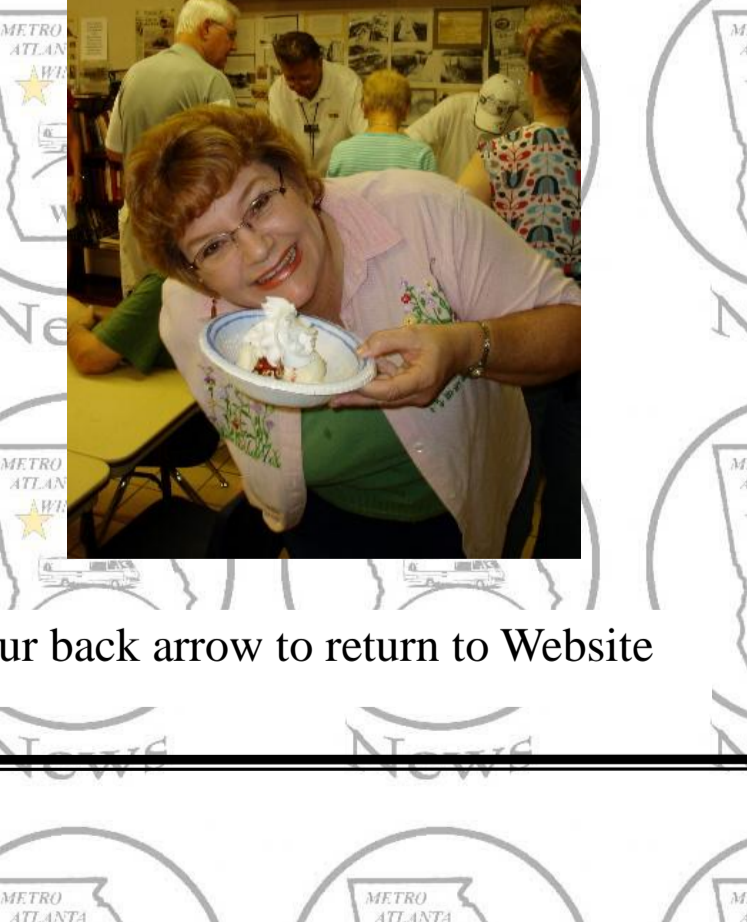
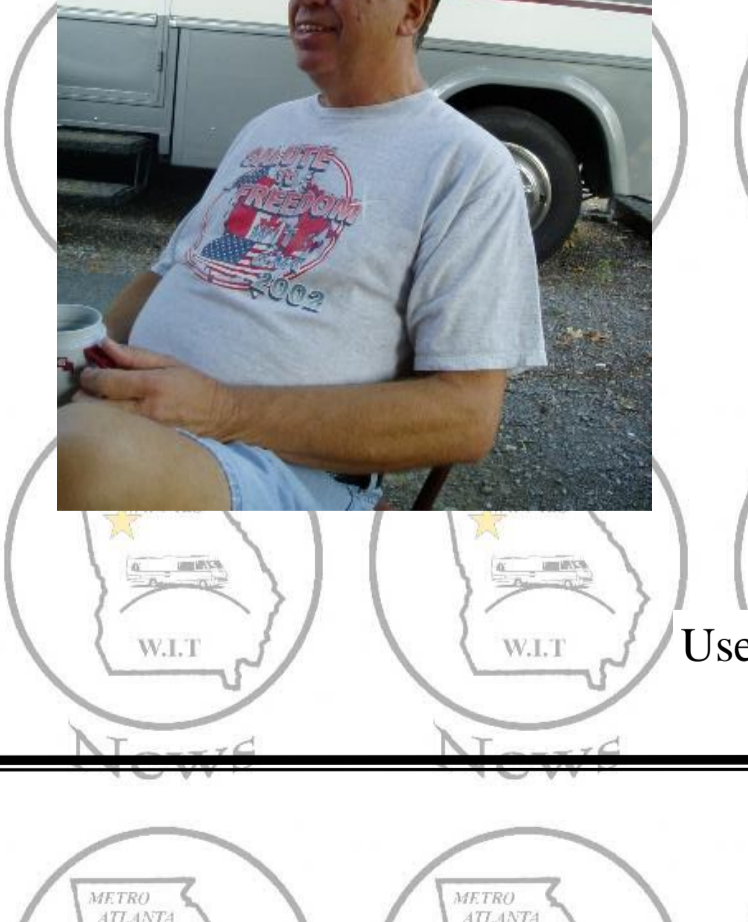
