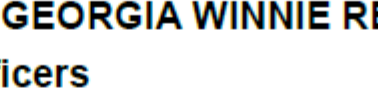

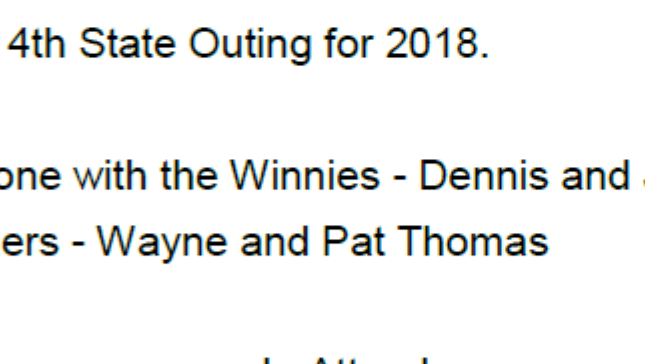

Our September State Outing was held at Twin Oaks RV Park – Elko GA



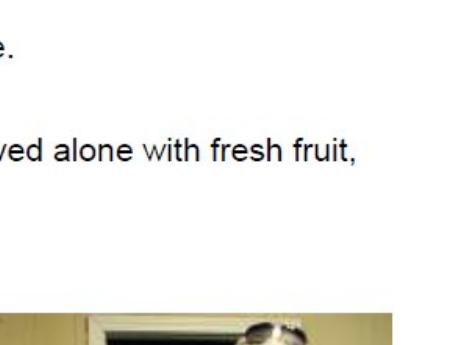
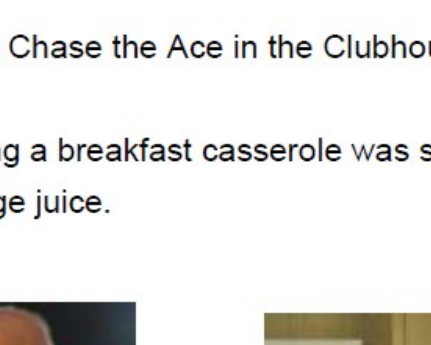
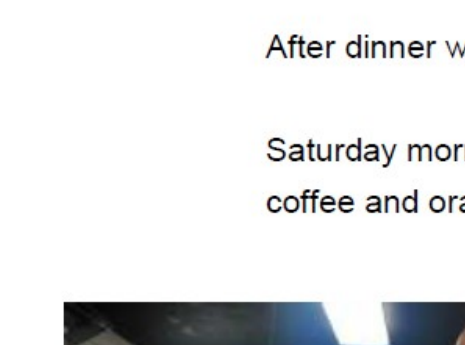
This was our 4th State Outing for 2018.

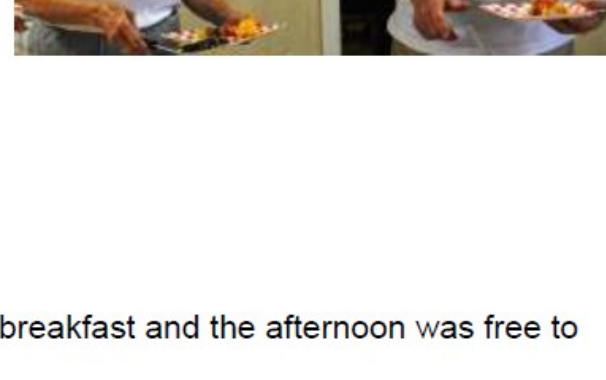
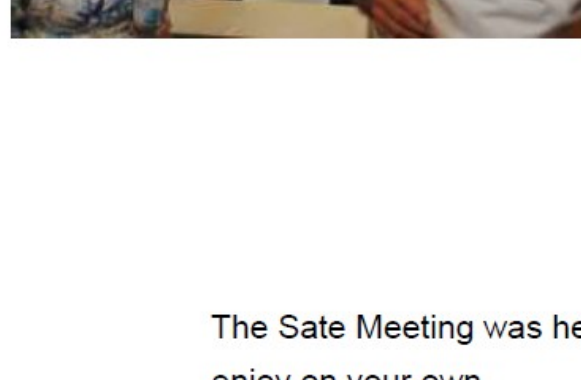

Saturday morning a breakfast casserole was served along with fresh fruit, coffee and orange juice.

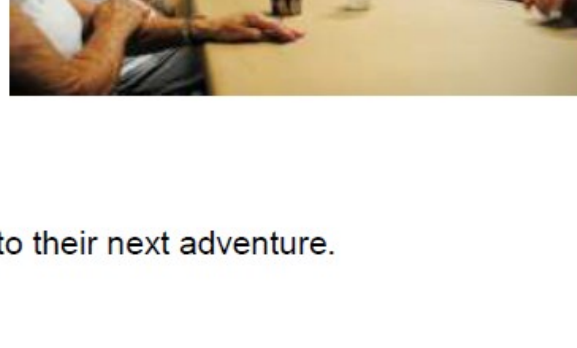


The State Meeting was held after breakfast and the afternoon was free to enjoy on your own.

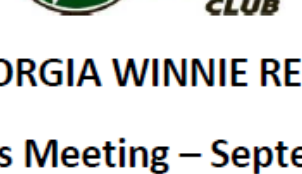

State Business Meeting – September 22, 2018

Twin Oaks RV Park - Elko, GA

Opening comments

Fred Tomsett, President called the meeting to order at 9:35 a.m. and led us in The Pledge of Allegiance

Franklin Jackson led us in prayer.

Meeting Minutes

Fred Tomsett asked for a motion to approve the meeting minutes for the April GWR state meeting as sent out via email. Pat Thomas made the motion to approve and Dennis Harrison seconded. The April minutes were approved by all.

Treasurer's Report

Fred Tomsett asked Linda Tomsett, Treasurer for the Treasurer's report which will include 2018 Rally Report. Beginning balance as of 4/1/18 is \$11,420.29 and the ending balance as of 8/31/18 is \$8,311.66.

The 2018 Rally Report was distributed to all members present. The expenses were \$6,439.17 and the Income was \$5,039.89. The difference is -\$1,399.28. This rally had less income and a higher entertainment expenses. For the 2019 rally we have raised the fee from \$60 to \$75 to better cover rally expenses.

Fred Tomsett asked for a motion to approve the treasurer's reports. Wayne Thomas made the motion to approve and Dennis Harrison seconded. The treasurer's reports were approved by all.

Linda reminded everyone that the 2019 annual dues are due in November. They are \$15 for chapter/\$10 for state club. Send one check for \$25 to the chapter treasurer.

Old Business

New Business

The January 2019 State meeting will be hosted by Sta-Goners on the 4th weekend (Jan. 25 -27) instead of the 3rd weekend as Twin Oaks was booked already.

Fred Tomsett discussed the 2019 Rally "Wild Wild West" which will be held from May 1 to 5 at the Bald Mountain RV Park and he passed out applications. He reminded everyone to bring donations for the GA basket and the cake walk. He will ask for rally volunteers at the January meeting. The campground will be handling the site reservations directly just like we did with the rallies in Brunswick. He will be sending out rally applications to all former rally attendees to try to get more participation as we do not have a limit on the number of sites at this campground. He stated that the Florida group bought, signed and gave him a thank you card which he really appreciated.

We need to try to get new members for our state club. If you see someone with a Winnebago product, talk to them and invite them to an outing. The state and chapter presidents get lists of new members and have been sending out letters but we are not getting a good response from that. They do not give us their phone numbers.

A member asked why we did not combine the remaining two chapters into one big chapter and they were told that the Sta-Goners voted not to do this for various reasons.

Each chapter reminded members of the upcoming outings:
Stat-Goners will be at Cecil Bay RV on Oct. 5, 6, 7, Pine Mountain on Nov 2, 3, 4 and KOA Richmond Hill on Dec 7, 8, 9.

Gone With The Winnies will be at River Bend, Hiawassee on Nov. 9, 10, 11 and River Country Campground, Gadsden, AL on Dec 7, 8, 9.

Meeting Adjournment

Fred Tomsett asked for a motion to close the meeting. Kris Yontz made the motion to close and Dennis Harrison seconded. The meeting was adjourned at 10:00 a.m.
